- In 1997, the board of the Chaplin Center decided to extend the space for exhibitions and storage, and also to establish the Museum of New Art in Pärnu
- #In 1998 we started built MONA







**We are private museum without regular support. For money we have organize different projects to aim money from Cultural Endowment of Estonia, from Pärnu Town Government and Ministry of Culture.






